Transcript of the East Isley Poor Book (Overseer's accounts)
July 1744 to June 1752

Notes:

There is no cover page surviving and the first page does not give a year, but working back from later pages, it would be 1744. Note that the calendar is old-style with the year ending 25 March, so January 1745 follows December 1745. Such dates are written as Jan 1745/46. Where the year has been inferred but is not actually written in the book, it is shown in brackets as [1744].

Numerous abbreviations have been used throughout the book, particularly for names. These have been expanded to give the full name. The inserted letters are shown in square brackets e.g. Rich[ar]d for Rich^d.

As usual at this time period, the spelling is very variable and is often approximately phonetic. Initial capital letters are often used within a phrase. This transcript uses the original spelling throughout.

The end of each page in the original is shown by a line in this transcript.

Sometimes the name of the overseer dealing with the accounts is shown at the top of the page, alongside the date. In East Isley, the accounts were made up every 28 days.

The sums of money paid out are in £-s-d, so an entry shown as 0-5-6 is for 5 shillings and sixpence.

Notes on people in the Overseers accounts (1744-1752)

ALLEN	William Allen received occasional payments in 1748 and 1749
ARCHER	Francis Archer received occasional payments in 1744 for her boys. John Archer also received occasional payments 1745 to 1746
ARNOLD	John Arnold received occasional payments in 1749 to 1751. Ann Arnold's house rent paid in 1746
ASHCOMBE	Widow Ashcombe was Elizabeth, widow of Ambrose Ashcombe who was buried Oct 1745 in EI. They were not married in EI but their children were baptised here between 1690 and 1705. Ambrose was baptised in 1664 in E I.
BOULTON	See SAYER
BROWN	Widow Brown is Elizabeth, the widow of James Brown who was buried in 1716 in E.Ilsley. Their children were baptised in E.ilsley between 1685 and 1708 but the couple were not married here.
CAMPION	Richard Campion (or Champin or Chapman) - regular payments of 5 shillings a month up to Sep 1750, then 4 s/ month Richard Campion married Elizabeth Boulton in 1743 – no baptisms in EI
CARTER	John Carter – regular payments of 4 s/month
COKES	James Cokes – occasional payments in 1745, 1748, 1749
COSTARD	Costards children – Robert and Sarah Costard (or Costerd) children were baptised in EI between 1724 and 1735. Robert married Sarah Spicer in 1723 in E. Hendred. Sarah was buried in EI in 1736 but Robert was not buried here. Regular payments of 8s/month to Oct 1746 (for 2 children), then 4s/month to Sep 1749
COWDERRY	Payments to Thomas Cowderry's wife in 1752 while pregnant, assistance with house rent and expenses at childbirth
FIELD	John Field – occasional payments 1748 to 1750
FOSTER	Regular payments of 12s/month to Ignatious Foster to Nov 1747, then 6s/month to Sep 1748 (after wife died). Occasional payments for clothing. Ignatious Foster was baptised in EI in 1663 and was buried in Dec 1748 – see Overseers accounts for his funeral expenses. He married Elizabeth Rudde in Jan 1686 in Basildon/Ashampstead. Elizabeth Foster was buried in Dec 1747 – her funeral expenses are also in the Overseers accounts.
FRY	Mary Fry –regular payments of 4s/month Nov 1746 to May 1747
GRACE	Elizabeth Grace – regular payments of 4s/month from Jun 1749 to Jun 1752, plus clothing for her son. Francis was the illegitimate son of Elizabeth Grace, baptised Mar 1740/41
GRAY	Richard Gray received frequent payments (variable amounts) but was not on a regular payment schedule. Occasional payments for his wife's expenses at childbirth
HOUSE	Richard House – occasional payments in 1745
ILSLEY	Widow Ilsley – regular payments of 6s/month until Sep 1748, then her funeral expenses. Widow Ilsley is Judith, the widow of Thomas Ilsley who was buried in EI in 1712. Their children were baptised in EI between 1701 and 1705. Judith was buried in EI in Aug 1748
LAWRENCE	William Lawrence – small payments for few months before he died, then funeral expenses Feb 1747/48
LOVEGROVE	Thomas Lovegrove – single small payment in Feb 1747/48
NICHOLLS	Regular payment of 12s/month until May 1748, then 8s to Oct 1749. House rent of 2s/month paid from Jun 1750 to Jun 1752. Elizabeth is the widow of Thomas Nicholls, who was buried in EI in 1741. Elizabeth Perry married Thomas Nicholls in 1720 in EI and their children were baptised between 1721 and 1737 in EI
ORCHARD	John Orchard –single payment in Nov 1745
PERRY	Joseph Perry – occasional payments 1746, 1747 and 1751
PRYOR	Henry Pryor – occasional payments 1748 to 1750, including payment for work on the highways John Pryor – payments for work on the highways in 1749/50
RUDD	Widow Rudd – regular payment of 6s/month until Jan 1749/50. Widow Rudd is probably the widow of John Rudd. John & Elizabeth Rudd had children baptised between 1695 and 1707. Elizabeth Rudd was buried in Jan 1749/50. Rudd children (2) – regular payment of 12s/month to Jan 1744/45. These are probably the children of Thomas & Anne Rudd, baptised 1732 (Anne) and 1733 (William). Anne Rudd was buried in 1733 (was this the mother?). Thomas Rudd married Anne Ballard in Feb 1721/32

RUMBLE	Giles Rumble – regular payments of 5s/month for Aug & Sep 1751 then 4s/month until May 1752
SAYER	Sayers children – regular payments of 10s/month to Jan 1744/45, then 12s/month until Sep 1749, then 6s/month to Jun 1752. Sayers children – Amon Sayer married Frances Ward in 1724 in EI. They had 10 children baptised between 1723 and 1740 in EI, at least 6 of these surviving. Amon Sayer senr. was buried in 1742 in EI. The widow Francis Sayer married Stephen Boulton in 1743, so payments for the Sayer children were made to him. Amon Sayer was baptized 1734, one of the Sayers children Elizabeth Sayer – variable payments from Apr 1746 to Aug 1746, during childbirth, then funeral expenses. Her illegitimate son, Colman, was paid for (at Robert Cannons) until his funeral in Feb 1747/48
SHARP	John Sharp – occasional payments 1744, 1748, 1749
SMITH	Thomas Smith – regular payments of 12s/month from Jan 1747/48 to Nov 1748, then 8s/month to Jun 1752
SPIKE	Richard Spike – variable but regular payments Mar 1747/48 to Mar 1748/49, then funeral expenses Deborah Spike – funeral expenses Dec 1747 Martha Spike – variable but regular payments Apr 1749 to Sep 1749, then funeral expenses Mary Spike – regular payments of 6s/month Oct 1749 to Jun 1752 to Cannons, clothing payments. Mary was the daughter of Richard & Martha, baptised 1736
TARLTON	Thomas Tarlton – occasional payments to 1747, then regular variable payments Jan 1747/48 to Sep 1750, including house rent, then funeral expenses. Baptised 1679. John Tarlton – regular payments of 6s/month Dec 1747 to Mar 1750/51. Baptised 1670, buried Feb 1750/51
WADKINS	John Wadkins – payments to doctor, lodging, costs of sending him to London and then his funeral expenses in London – all in 1750
WALGROVE	Elizabeth Walgrove – single payment in Jun 1747
WEEKS	William Weeks – received payment for Mary Fry’s lodging expenses
WELLMAN	Elizabeth Wellman – variable amounts paid for lodging and nursing during childbirth Oct 1744 to Mar 1744/45. Illegitimate daughter, Elizabeth Hancock Wellman, baptised Nov 1744. John Wellman – doctor’s bill, clothing, rent and regular payments Dec 1751 to Jun 1752
WESTALL	William Westall – occasional payments, also payment for lodging Ann Arnold
WILKINS	Thomas Wilkins – single payment Jan 1745/46

General info:

Gaol money had nothing to do with poor rates but was an additional county tax that had to be paid by each parish for the upkeep of gaols. For convenience it was administered and collected as part of the poor rates. Other expenses frequently recorded include -

- Clerk’s dues £1 1s for year
- Digging a grave and ringing the bell 2s
- Coffin 7s 6d
- Child’s coffin 3s 6d
- Shroud 4s
